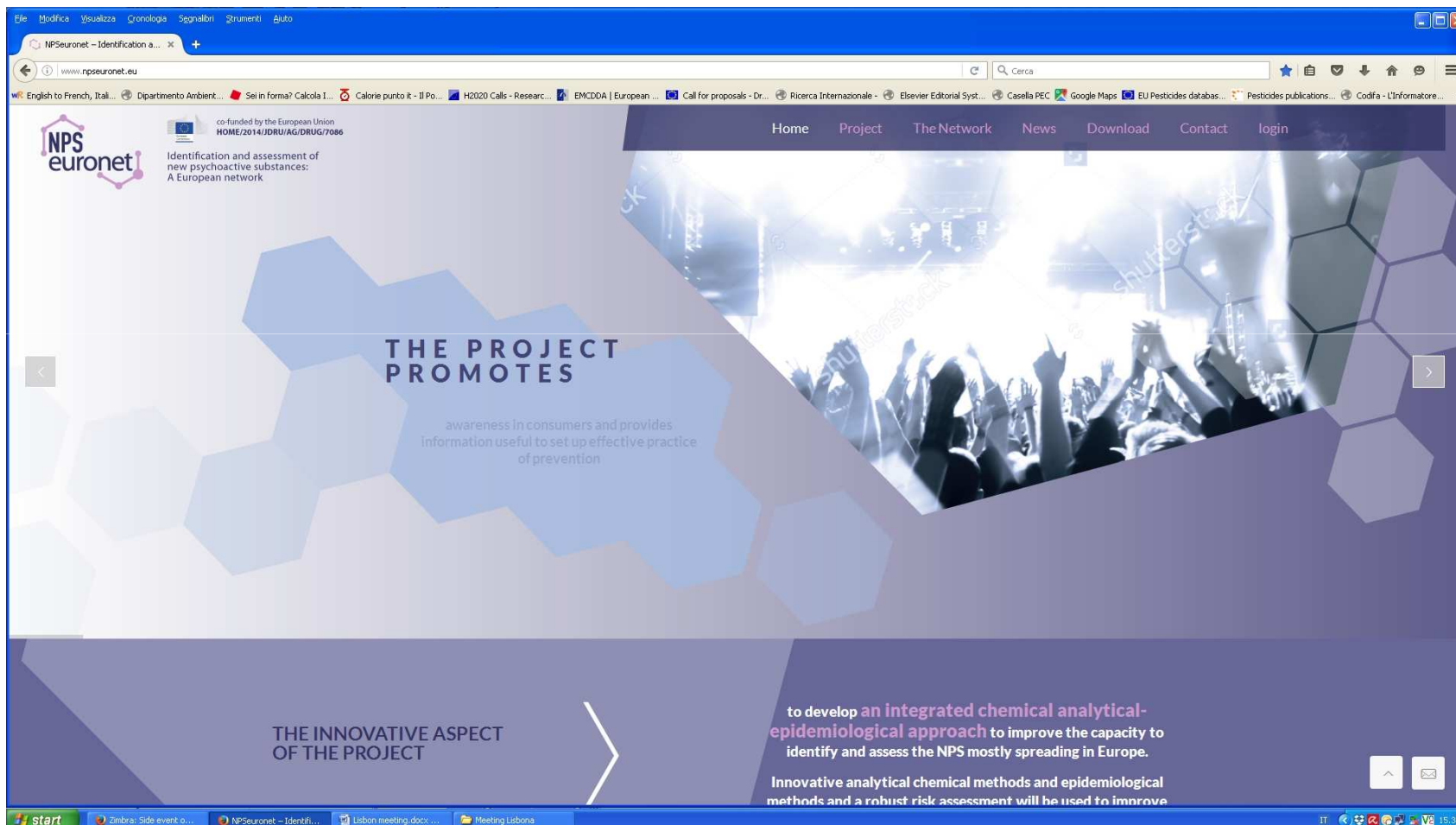

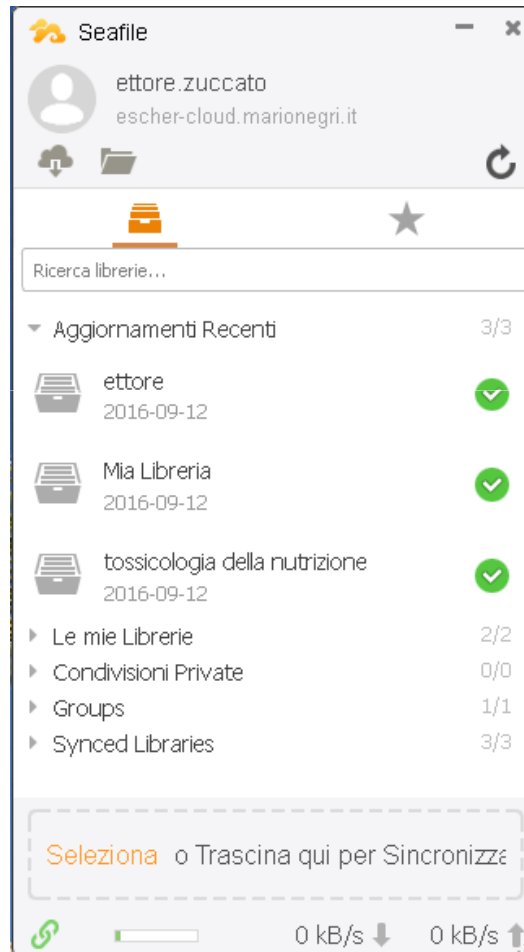

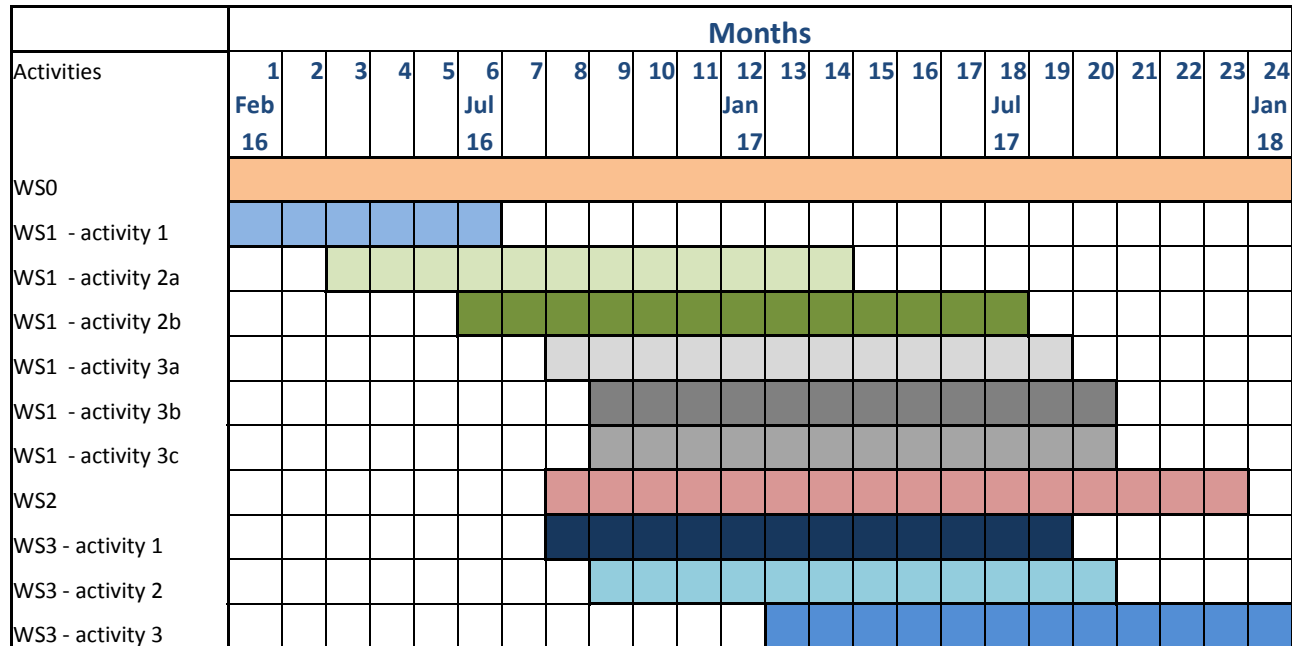

Urine collection at Øya Festival (Norway)

Sampling site: Øya Festival (Oslo), one of the largest rock music festival in Norway.

The samples were collected daily, for three consecutive days (11-12-13 Aug.). A fraction of the urine pool was transferred into a metal bin and then into inert plastic bottles.

1L of sample has been collected for each of the three days of activities, transported to the NIVA and frozen at -20°C until SPE.

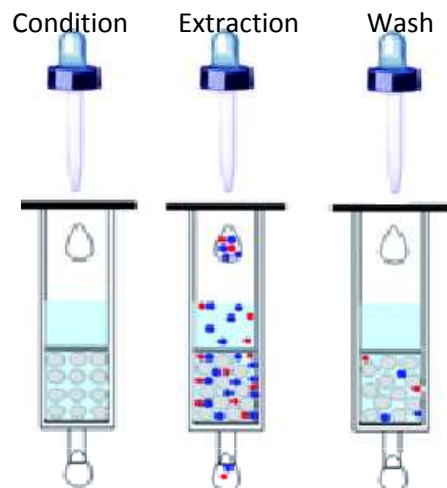
The sampling was done in collaboration with the Norwegian Institute for water research (NIVA).

SOLID PHASE EXTRACTION



The SPE was performed using Oasis HLB cartridges (150mg).

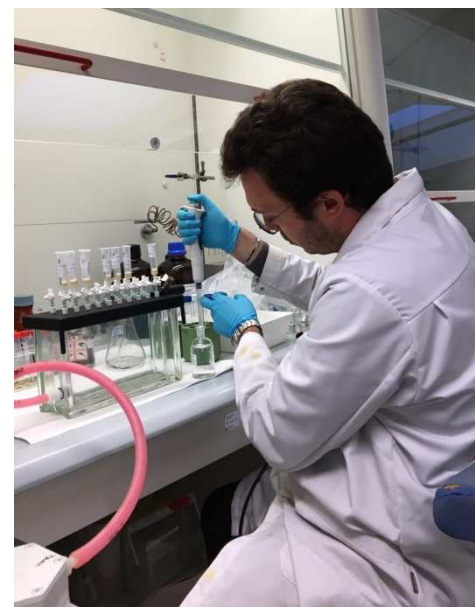
Condition: 5 mL MeOH + 5 mL MilliQ water

Extraction: 5 mL of pooled urine

Wash: 5 mL of MilliQ water were loaded after the urine in order to remove the salts.

Before the SPE an aliquot for each urine sample was centrifuged for 2 minutes at 2500 rpm.

The SPE was made in triplicate.

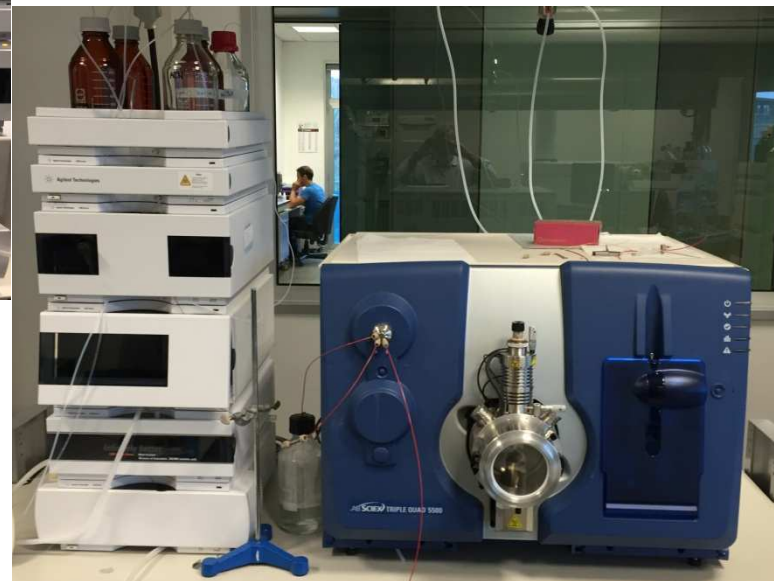
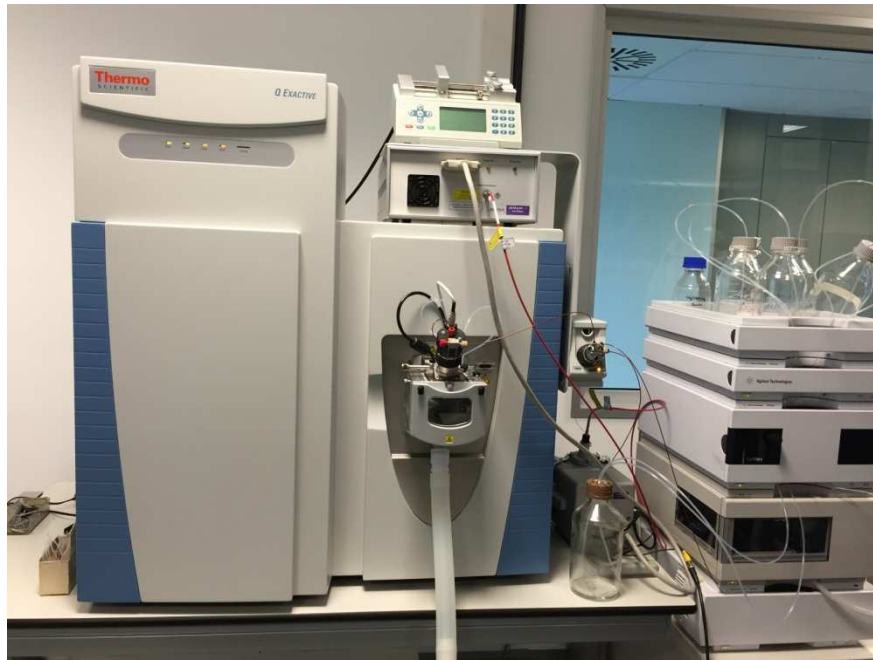
